Tuition Rates for New Students 2021 - 2022 School Year

Dear Parent,

We are very excited and looking forward to the 2021-2022 school year. We are glad to welcome your family to the Good Shepherd School community. We provide a Christian environment where we are dedicated to a program of excellence designed to train the mind, strengthen values, and foster the spirit and faith of each and every child enrolled in our school.

We will be using RenWeb for Online Enrollment and the FACTS Management Program for tuition collections. All online applications must be completed before your registration will be accepted. This includes the nonrefundable \$450 registration fee. The registration fee is due with the registration application or an additional \$150 will be charged as a late fee.

All students new to Good Shepherd School must supply us with the following information at the time of registration:

- Birth Certificate
- Baptismal Certificate, if Catholic
- Current Shot Records
- Latest Report Card (for 1st - 8th grade)
- Latest Copy of Standardized Test Scores (for 1st - 8th grades)

Registration cannot be completed without all of these documents.

Please be aware of the following financial commitments that are required for enrollment:

Registration fee: \$450 per family: The registration fee helps to defray the startup costs, including books, supplies, and budget items that must be paid before tuition payments start in July. This includes the \$50 instructional fee to cover costs of educational materials required for instruction and the enrollment fees RenWeb charges per family. The registration fee is nonrefundable.

Technology Fee: There is a \$25 technology fee for use of school laptops in grades 6-8 to be collected in August.

Testing: There is a \$25 testing fee for new students entering kindergarten and grades 1-8.

Kindergarten - All students will be tested during the first and second weeks of May. Parents will be contacted by the office to set up testing. This test determines readiness for kindergarten and helps us prepare a program that best meets the children's needs.

Grades 1-8 - The school office will contact new students to set up a testing time. Students transferring from another Catholic school may have testing waived based on report cards and standardized test results. The principal will make this determination. Testing for 1st - 8th grades helps us to assess student strengths and weaknesses in order to make sure that we can provide the proper environment for the student. The principal will notify the parents regarding the testing results.

Extended Day Program: An after school care program is available for an additional charge per day. See the Extended Day information page in Online Enrollment to determine your day care needs. There is a \$30 registration fee to sign up for this program.

Lunch Program: : **If we can open the cafeteria** Good Shepherd School will offer a hot lunch program through E & E Food Services. There is an additional charge to purchase lunches on a daily or monthly plan. Menus and debit accounts can be found at myschoolaccount.com.

Uniforms: Each student in Pre-K 3 through 8th grade is required to wear a school uniform purchased only through Academic Outfitters. Prices can be determined by contacting the store at 972-509-0010 or going to their website www.aoutfitters.com. There will be a discount period in June to purchase uniforms and shoes.

Volunteering: All families are required to volunteer 30 hours at Good Shepherd School for a reduction in tuition. The school could not offer the quality of education, service and sense of community that it does without parental involvement. To avoid the tuition assessment, volunteer hours must be completed by the given deadlines.

Note: All tuition payments for the 2021-2022 school year must be paid in full by June 20, 2022. If you choose the FACTS Tuition Payment Plan there is a \$45 processing fee. There is a no fee for one payment and \$10 for two.

Financial Aid: There are two sources of financial aid available to Good Shepherd Catholic School families. There is a \$35 fee to apply online through the FACTS Grant and Aid website: <https://online.factsmgt.com/signin/44JBG>

1. Diocese of Dallas Tuition Assistance (The HALO Initiative) - for students in kindergarten-8th grade only
2. Good Shepherd Tuition Assistance Program - for all students in Pre-K* through grade 8

Note: financial aid is awarded based on need as determined through the FACTS application process.

*Preschool students that qualify for tuition assistance are limited to a maximum of \$2,000 per student.

Financial aid is awarded to registered families only. Additional volunteer hours or fundraising requirements will be required as part of the financial aid agreement.
